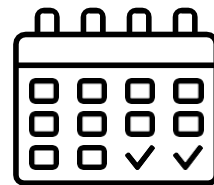

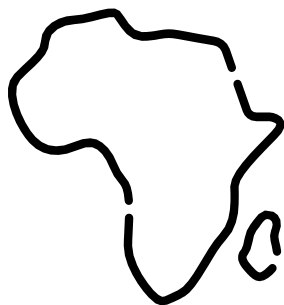

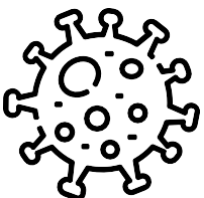
PASTORAL CARE PRAYER CHAIN

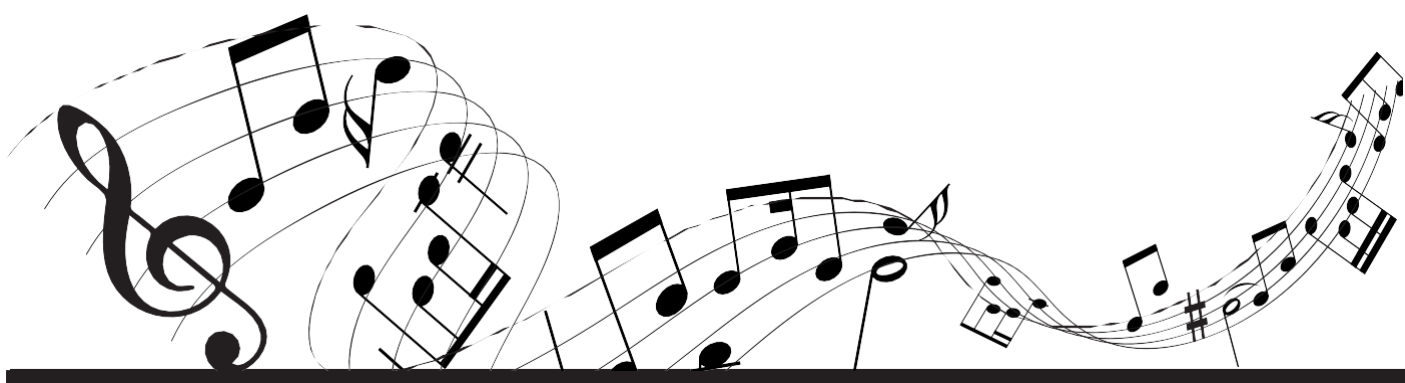
- 1 The Lord hear thee in the day of trouble:

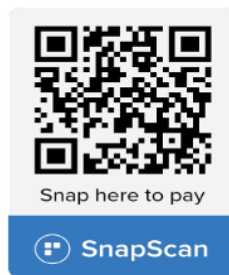
