

## Dedicated Giving Report – Vestry 2021

During the year Andrew del Boccio and family returned to the USA leaving the sensitive position of director of Dedicated Giving vacant, I have agreed to fill the position while a more permanent appointment can be found. Andrew was ably assisted by Dale Howell who shortly thereafter fell ill and has been incapacitated since then. We wish her a full recovery and look forward to welcoming her back into the DG fold.

Unfortunately her illness, the confidential nature of the function and my lack of technical ability and time to handle the communication to individual givers has meant that communication has been on a broad basis and individual letters have not been sent to each giver. I sincerely apologise for this and hope that you will understand. I assure you that record of your giving has been meticulously maintained, is sincerely appreciated and has been a major contribution to the morale of our staff and also the financial survival of the parish under the difficult circumstances of lockdown. I wish to thank all our givers for their generous response by continuing and in many cases increasing their contributions to the parish over the past year.

The current DG year began in July 2020 and ends June 2021 and forecast income is R 1.7 million. This is R 5% down on the previous DG year due to the loss of several major donors.

The figures below shows the split of the contributions

5 parishioners contribute 30%  
15 parishioners a further 26%  
22 parishioners a further 16% and  
96 parishioners the balance of 28%

This shows the dependence that we have on a few parishioners for over 50% of our DG which is by far the major contribution to our income. We ask all parishioners to consider becoming regular givers, the broader our base of givers, the more stable our income will be.
